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ANSWERS TO THE FAQs

1. When are the **entrance exams held?**

The entrance exams for 2022-2023 academic year will be held 7 times:

- February 7 (for contract)
- March 7 (for contract)
- April 7 (for contract)
- May 7 (for contract)
- June 7 (for contract)
- July 7 (for scholarship)
- August 25 (for contract)

※ *AKFA University admission dates and times are subject to change depending on the number of applicants . Remember to check the University website regularly to be notified of changes . The online application process will run until July 1. Also, if the admission quota is paid for all faculties , there is a possibility that the exam scheduled for August 25 will not be held.*

2. **How many times can I take the entrance exams?**

Applicants have the opportunity to take the entrance exam only 2 times.
once for a contract (*they can choose the day of the exam*) and once for a scholarship (July 7).

※ To participate in the scholarship exam, the applicant must score at least 40% of max. score in the contract exam

3. How many departments can applicants apply for in the **entrance exams** ?

Applicants can apply for only 1 faculty

4. **What specialties are there in AU?**

Currently, AKFA University has the following specialties:

- School of Medicine: *Medicine, Pharmacy, Dentistry and Higher Nursing ;*
- Business School: *Accounting and Finance, Economics, International Business , Digital Marketing, Startup Management ;*
- Technical direction : *Architecture and Design, Construction Engineering, Computer Engineering and Software Engineering;*
- Field of study: *Journalism and English.*
- Area of Law: *Commercial Law.*
- Exact Sciences: *Applied Mathematics.*

5. Which subjects are tested in the entrance exams?

6. When will the results of the entrance exams be announced?

Results of the entrance exam will be published individually on the official website of the university (www.akfauniversity.org) and [by](#) e - mail on the day of each exam .

※ *AKFA University admission and examination times may vary depending on the number of applicants . Be sure to check the AKFA University website regularly to be notified of any changes to the schedule .*

7. Are the questions in the entrance exams compiled by the State Testing Center (STC) or DTM?

AU entrance exams have nothing to do with DTM . Only professors from the Gachon University of Korea and AKFA University are responsible for this process.

8. What documents are required to apply to the AU?

- Passport;
- College / lyceum diploma or school certificate (if you are still studying, reference from the place of study);
- Certificate of English (IELTS / TOEFL / Duolingo / IEPTE);
- 3.5 × 4.5 image (must be taken on a white, clear background and within the last 3 months) .

※ *in scanned version and in jpg format .*

9. How to apply to AU?

Applicants apply online through the University's official website <https://akfauniversity.org/local-admission/>

10. How long does continuation of application process?

Online application process for the 2022/2023 academic year will run from January 10 (2022year) to August 20 (2022year).

※ *AKFA University admission and examination times may vary depending on the number of applicants . Remember to check the AKFA University website regularly to be notified of any changes .*

11. What is the required level of English language proficiency?

medical department (Medicine , Pharmacy and Dentistry):

- IELTS 5.5, TOEFL iBT 55 , Duo lingo 90 and higher

For other faculties:

- IELTS 5.0, TOEFL iBT 50, Duo lingo 80 and higher

※ Those with an IELTS 5 or higher (or equivalent) certificate are admitted on a contract basis only without an entrance exam to the faculties of Journalism and English.

12. Is it possible to apply without a certificate of English language proficiency? (IELTS / TOEFL iBT / Duolingo)?

Yes, you can apply and take the exam. But, applicants must submit a scanned version of the certificate by June 27th. Applicants who do not have a certificate will be asked to take the University's English language proficiency test.

13. Is it possible to apply if English language certificate (IELTS / TOEFL and BT / Duolingo) has expired ?

No. The validity of the IELTS / TOEFL iBT or Duolingo certificate is 2 years, at the time of application the certificate must be received after August 5 , 2020

14. Is an original diploma required during the application process?

You need to upload a scanned version of your diploma or certificate of enrollment when applying online . Upon successful completion of the exams , you will be asked to bring an original copy after becoming an AU student .

15. What documents are required after successfully passing admission process?

Upon completion of the admission process , students admitted to the university must bring an original copy of their college / lyceum diploma or school certificate to the University .

16. Can original documents be sent by fax or online ?

No, students are only asked to bring the original documents in person .

17. Is it for a second specialty ?

Yes, applicants for a second major at AU must go through the same admission processes and exams as other applicants

18. What is the duration of study at AKFA University ?

- Faculty of Medicine, Pharmacy and Dentistry - 6 years (2 years - Pre - medicine and 4 years - Medicine phase)
- Faculty of Accounting and Finance, Economics, International Business, Digital Marketing, Startup Management, Architecture and Design, Civil Engineering, Applied Mathematics, Computer Engineering and Software Engineering, Commercial Law, Journalism - 4 years
- English, Higher Nursing - 3 years

19. What is

The annual payment of AU for citizens of Uzbekistan is as follows:

- Faculty of Medicine - 58,000,000 soums for each academic year, 29,000,000 soums for one semester. (Pre-Medicine phase is 2 years, for 1 year contract price is 42 million soums, 1 semester is 21 million soums)
- Faculty of Pharmacy and Dentistry - 42,000,000 soums for each academic year, 21,000,000 soums for one semester.
- Higher nursing school - 20,000,000 soums for each academic year, 10,000,000 soums for one semester.
- Accounting and Finance - 29,000,000 soums for each academic year , 14,500,000 soums for one semester.
- Economics, Architecture and Design, Faculty of Civil Engineering, Computer Engineering and Software engineering faculties - 27,000,000 soums for each academic year, 13,500,000 soums for one semester.

- Digital Marketing, International Business, Startup Management, Commercial Law and Journalism - 25,000,000 soums for each academic year , 12,500,000 soums for one semester.
- Faculties of Applied Mathematics and English Education - 24,000,000 soums for each academic year , 12,000,000 soums for one semester.

20. What does the annual fee cover?

The annual fee is for academic services only. Please note that the fee does not cover the cost of dormitory .

21. When is the deadline for payment of the contract ?

Each entrant admitted to AU must make an initial payment for the contract within 10 working days (14 calendar days) from the date of publication of the exam results. Remaining amount should be paid within 2 weeks after beginning of the study.

22. Is there a student dormitory at the university?

There is a student dormitory in the campus area. Nowadays, a modern building for 500 students with all amenities has been completed and commissioned (a total of 3,000 people).

23. In what language are classes taught at AU?

All AU curricula are taught in English only (there are no Uzbek or Russian language groups).

24. Is the AU diploma valid in Uzbekistan and other countries?

Yes. You can check from the site lex.uz for Uzbekistan and search.wdoms.org for United States and United Kingdom

25. Is it necessary to nostrify a diploma in Uzbekistan?

No. If you want to work for local companies or government agencies, nostrification of the diploma is not required.

26. Are scholarships available at AU?

AU currently offers 4 types of scholarships to its students. Terms and conditions of the scholarship are available at <https://akfauniversity.org/scholarships/>.

27. Are there any grants for students in the AU entrance exams?

Yes, AU offers 10-100% scholarships on a competitive basis for the best local students who score high on the entrance exam. However, student scholarship status may vary depending on academic performance each semester.

28. When are vacation periods for AU students?

AU students go on winter vacation (December-January) and summer vacation (May ~ August). Please keep in mind that holiday times are subject to change. In such cases, the AU Administration notifies students in advance.

29. I am currently a university student. Can I transfer my studies to AU ?

Yes, you can. AU has an active transfer program and AU administration can review applications to make the transfer. At the same time, every entrant - student must meet all the requirements for transfer. 30. Are disabled students given additional benefits?

AU does not impose any restrictions on the admission of students with physical disabilities and, like other applicants, admits them in the entrance exam only on a selective basis. The campus has elevators, open spaces, rest areas for the convenience of such students, and the interiors of the buildings are equipped and customized as needed.

31. Is there a lyceum under AU?

AU does not currently have a lyceum. In the future, a lyceum may be opened under the AU. But at the same time, the university has a 2-year AUPSP program for grades 10-11 and preparatory courses for 9th graders and above.

32. Can AU students transfer their studies to other universities ?

AU students can make a transfer to another university. However, they must comply with the requirements of the university where the transfer is to take place.

33. Do AU graduates have the opportunity to work abroad?

AU graduates can work in large companies abroad with their high qualifications and English language proficiency. AU prefers to train highly qualified specialists for the Uzbek economy and does not encourage students to work abroad. There is a constant demand for highly educated and professional staff and they can work in high-paying jobs without leaving their home countries.

34. Can AU students participate in the Work & Travel program during the summer vacation?

Each year, the US Embassy in Tashkent organizes a summer Work & Travel program for students. Interested students can visit the website and learn more about the program (<https://uz.usembassy.gov/visas/non-immigrant-visas/nonimmigrant-visas-study-exchange/summer-work-and-travel/>). Please do this keep in mind that AU has no partnership with this program. However, the AU Administration will provide the necessary information that the student is studying at the university.

35. I am a citizen of another country (but I live in Uzbekistan) . Can I apply to AU ?

36. Is there any age limit for applying to AKFA University?

AU is strongly opposed to age discrimination. According to the legislation in the field of education, anyone, regardless of age, gender and ethnicity, can easily apply to the university. All students are guaranteed the same treatment.
